Smoking at Tunkuwallin Reserve

Amendments to the Smoke-free Environment Act 2000, came into effect on 07/01/2013 which prohibits smoking within certain public areas.

Smoke-free Environment Act 2000 No 69

Section 6A Smoke-free areas—outdoor public places

- (1) An outdoor public place is a **smoke-free area** for the purposes of this Act if it is any of the following places (or part of any of those places):
 - (c) an area set aside for or being used by spectators to watch an organised sporting event at a sports ground or other recreational area, but only when an organised sporting event is being held there

The Act also allows local councils to introduce their own regulations, accordingly Wyong Shire Council have designated the Tunkuwallin Oval reserve as a smoke free zone
